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**CALL FOR BURSARY NOMINATIONS TO ATTEND
THE INTERNATIONAL SAIL TRAINING AND TALL SHIP CONFERENCE**

**SEVILLE, SPAIN
29 NOVEMBER – 1 DECEMBER 2018**

Sail Training International Asia-Pacific is calling for nominations from the Australian and New Zealand Tall Ships and Sail Training community to attend the International Sail Training Conference to be held in the city of Seville, Spain from Thursday 29 November – Saturday 1 December 2018. Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand is responsible for management of the nomination and selection process.

Six individual bursaries, funded by Sail Training International, are offered to offset costs for successful applicants from either Australia or New Zealand to travel to Spain to attend the conference.

To be eligible for nomination you must be:

- an existing financial member of Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand who has made contributions to Sail Training in Australia and/or New Zealand
or
- a representative of a financial Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand Operator Member or a Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand Organisation Member
or
- a young person within the Sail Training community who has the potential and is likely to make a significant contribution to Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand and is a member of Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand prior to commencement of the 2018 conference.

Application Process:

Applications should be in the form of a letter. This letter must be supported by an accompanying letter from a financial Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand Operator or Committee Member confirming the applicant's eligibility and reasons for attending the conference. Application is to be made no later than Wednesday **13 July 2018**.

Supporting personal development through tall ship experiences.

Terms and Conditions:

Bursaries are awarded in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- evidence of receipts for the purchase of return airfares to Spain must be provided to the Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand Treasurer
- bursaries are not transferable
- should travel to Spain not be undertaken from either Australia or New Zealand or the Conference in Seville not be attended, the bursary is to be repaid in full
- a written report (no less than 500 words) outlining the benefits gained and lessons learned is to be forwarded to the Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand International Representative **within 30 days** of the attendee's return to Australia or New Zealand. This will be posted to the Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand website.
- The Bursary is to the value of £800 (paid to recipients by Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand in AU/NZ dollars).
