**THE BILLY CAN TROPHY
NOMINATION GUIDANCE**

The following nomination guidance is provided with regard to the annual award of the Tall Ships Australia and New Zealand Billy Can Trophy.

In years that a Tall Ship Race is held (excluding Sydney Harbour Races), the trophy is awarded to the TANZ tall ship with the best corrected time over a 48 hour run.

In years a Tall Ship Race is not held, the trophy is awarded to:

- a. A TANZ tall ship or operator member organisation for outstanding achievement in youth development through sail training.
- b. An individual TANZ member, operator member, volunteer or employee who has, over an extended period, provided an invaluable contribution in the support of personal development through the sail training experience.

The Billy Can Trophy is held on TANZ's behalf by the Sydney Heritage Fleet and is on permanent display at Wharf 7, Darling Harbour, New South Wales.

A replica trophy is presented and held by the Awardee for twelve months following the award, after which the Trophy is presented to the subsequent Awardee.

Nominations for the Award are to reach the Secretary by the specified date using the nomination template. Tall Ships and Member Organisations should not hesitate to forward self-nominations.

The Awardee will be announced each year at the Annual General Meeting and publicised in the TANZ newsletter and website.
